- One of the nation's largest utilities, SCE is an investor-owned utility, a private company owned by shareholders/investors and regulated by the California Public Utilities Commission and Federal Energy Regulatory Commission
- Headquarters in Rosemead, California
- Nearly 140 years of history

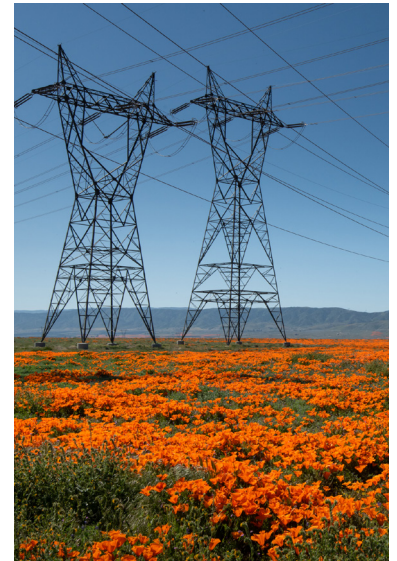


Who We Serve

- 50,000 square miles of SCE service area across Central, Coastal and Southern California
- 184 cities, 15 counties and 15 Native American tribes
- 15+ million residents
- 5.2+ million customer accounts

Operations and Revenue

- 125,000+ circuit miles of distribution and bulk transmission lines.
- Our profits are not tied to the amount of electricity we deliver. The CPUC allows SCE the opportunity to earn a fixed profit on our capital investments — the infrastructure you see every day in your communities, such as poles, wires, substations, power plants and more.
- More than 80% of the electricity delivered to SCE customers is generated by independent power producers.
- To continue powering California's growing population and economy, SCE plans to invest more than \$6 billion annually in a safe, reliable clean energy grid.
- SCE has the lowest system average rate of the three California investor-owned utilities and has a long history of cost management to support customer affordability.
- We invest in the electrical system infrastructure to keep it safe and reliable. We recover those costs through customer rates over the life of the assets, including a fair rate of return authorized by the CPUC.



Resiliency

- Installed over 6,000 miles of coated wire, known as [covered conductor](#), along with 48 miles of [undergrounding](#) since 2018.
- Added over 1,000 weather stations and 200 HD wildfire cameras throughout SCE's service area since 2018.
- Completed 1 million distribution inspections and 200,000 transmission inspections since 2018.

Reliability

- Replaced more than 25,000 distribution poles and 563 miles of conductor in the past two years.
- Installed 45,000 new distribution transformers in the past two years.

Clean Energy

- Forty-nine percent of the power SCE delivered to customers is estimated to have come from carbon-free sources, including wind and solar, along with other carbon-free sources such as large hydroelectric and nuclear power. SCE's estimated delivered power mix emitted approximately 67% fewer greenhouse gas emissions per unit of electricity compared to the latest available U.S. national average.
- We have no coal generation or contracts in our portfolio.
- In 2024, SCE interconnected approximately 30,000 behind-the-meter, solar-only installations and 39,000 energy storage and solar paired systems to the grid.
- With approximately 8,700 MW of energy storage installed or contracted, SCE has one of the largest energy storage portfolios in the nation. SCE's Charge Ready program is the largest light-duty EV charging program run by an investor-owned utility.
- By the end of 2024, SCE had installed infrastructure to support more than 7,000 charge ports at more than 400 sites.
- In 2024, SCE and Fervo Energy agreed to two 15-year power-purchase agreements for a total of 398 MW¹, making it one of the largest geothermal PPAs on record. This project could provide power to the equivalent of 350,000 homes across Southern California, ensuring 24/7 reliable, affordable clean energy for SCE's customers. The initial 70-MW phase of this project is expected to be operational by 2026, with the second phase in 2028.



SCE's Priorities

- Accelerating clean energy initiatives to achieve California's climate change, air quality and affordability goals: 100 percent carbon-free electricity by 2045, increased energy storage, and expanded transportation and building electrification.
- Modernizing the power grid for reliability, resilience and readiness.
- Mitigating climate change-related risks, including wildfires.
- Achieving operational and service excellence.
